
Let's Keep America's Drug Problem in Perspective

Estimated Causes of Preventable Deaths*



- ➤ 5 times as many people die from Alcohol each year than from illicit drugs and misuse of legal pharmaceuticals
- ➤ 15 times as many people die from poor diets and activity patterns
- ➤ 20 times as many people die from tobacco

Why arrest 1.6 million people each year for drugs? Does jailing drug users make more sense than jailing over weight people and smokers?
